Look Out For.....

From the Church of England: In light of the continued increase of COVID-19 cases in the UK, it is now necessary, according to the Church of England, to suspend the administration of the chalice as well as physical contact during the sharing of the peace, blessing or 'laying on of hands'. We therefore advise that all priests should offer communion in one kind only to all communicants i.e. the consecrated bread, with the priest alone taking the wine; suspend handshaking or other direct physical contact during the service; suspend direct physical contact as part of a blessing or 'laying on of hands.'

Please continue to observe good hygiene practices by coughing/sneezing into your sleeve or into a disposable tissue and disposing the tissue, and washing your hands for 20 seconds. Alcohol hand sanitizers should be used if soap and water are not available. Most importantly, if you are feeling poorly or you have come into contact with someone who is sick, please stay at home. Contact a member of the Pastoral Care Team to let them know that you are staying at home. Please let's help each other to stay well and to be well looked after.

Annual Meeting-Sunday, March 29th at 12.15pm. Please come as we celebrate together the good things God has been doing over the last year. Bring your lunch so we can eat together before beginning the meeting. The annual reports are available at the back of church. Please review them, including the minutes of last year's meeting.
